

Hair Dryers

Frequency: Before every use

Tools: Old toothbrush, damp cloth

Products: Detergent (optional)

Steps:

1. Check the vent or guard in the back of your hair dryer before styling your hair to see if it needs to be cleaned
2. If there is lint, remove the vent or guard
3. Using your old toothbrush, remove any lint that's there
4. Clean the nozzle and any attachments with your wet cloth
5. If water isn't strong enough to clean your attachments, use detergent and a toothbrush to remove any stubborn residue
6. Rinse thoroughly

Styling Irons

Frequency: Before every use

Tools: Damp cloth

Products: Rubbing alcohol

Steps:

1. Check the plates of your iron to see if there is any residue that needs to be removed
2. If so, turn on the iron to the lowest setting
3. When the iron is warm, use a damp cloth to wipe down the plates
4. If there is stubborn residue that won't come off, use rubbing alcohol first then follow up with your damp cloth
